CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. This General Permit Application may be submitted instead of a designed plan when the General Permit Criteria of Section 11 of the Delaware Sediment and Stormwater Regulations are met.
2. Project is linear in nature with earth disturbance less than six (6) feet in width.
3. Separate approval may be required from the DNREC relating to work in wetlands or subaqueous lands.
4. The approval of this permit does not relieve the applicant from complying with any and all Federal, State, County or Municipal laws and regulations.
5. In the event the applicant fails to provide adequate sediment control under the provisions of this permit, the Kent Conservation District reserves the right to require additional control measures as necessary OR require the preparation and implementation of a site specific plan.
6. **The applicant shall notify the Kent Conservation District at least five days prior to beginning construction. Phone 302-741-2600, ext. 3.**
7. Applies only on projects that are not contained within a broader Sediment and Stormwater Management Plan that has been approved for a concurrent development project.

FEES

Permit review and inspection fee is \$250.00 for utility work less than 6 feet wide and less than 1 mile in length. Submit payment at time of application. Make check payable to Kent Conservation District.

GRADING

- Existing sediment and stormwater control measures for concurrent site development shall be repaired by the utility contractor if they are damaged by the utility contractor.
- At any location where sediment laden run-off may exit the property, perimeter controls will be installed to prevent sediment from being transported off-site.
- Any sediment transported off-site to roads or road rights-of-way including ditches shall be removed. Any damage to ditches shall be repaired and stabilized to original condition.
- Grading shall not impair surface drainage, create an erosion hazard, or create a source of sediment to any adjacent watercourse or property owner.

STABILIZATION

- **Following initial soil disturbance or redisturbance, temporary or permanent stabilization with seed and mulch shall be completed within 14 days to the surface of all disturbed areas not actively under construction.**
- Specific stabilization requirements may be found in the Delaware Erosion and Sediment Control Handbook.
- Swales or other areas that transport concentrated flow will be stabilized with erosion control matting or sod.
